I - Guidelines for abstract submission:

- Free abstracts and Poster communications must be sent to the organizing committee until, through the following email address: cocongressointernacional@esel.pt;
- 2. Abstracts must report to projects as mentioned above;
- 3. Abstracts must comply with the instructions detailed in Point II:
- 4. Abstracts submitted for consideration must be original;
- 5. Abstracts must have a limit of **500 words**, Arial font size 12;

- Authors should send all procedural questions to the email cocongressointernacional@esel.pt;
- 7. Abstracts will be appreciated by the Scientific Committee, which will communicate the results to the reference author until **08.01.2025**
- If the abstract is accepted, at least one author must register for the event and send the communications in digital format (according to instructions) by 14.01.2025

II - Instructions for writing Abstracts

1. Authors:

- a. Present 1st name and surname or surnames (professional name of each author);
- b. Put the name of the author who performs the presentation of the communication or poster in bold if there is more than one author;
- c. Assign each author a number above the line to correspond to the remaining identifying elements;

2. **Title**:

a. Clarify the scope of the project (maximum 16 words);

3. Summary - Content:

a. Research Project Summaries

- Abstracts should include: Introduction, conceptual framework, Method (objective/research question, type of study; participants; methodological procedures for data collection, evaluation and analysis; ethical aspects); results, discussion and conclusions, Implications; Keywords (maximum 5);
- ii. A maximum of 5 bibliographic references (APA Standard -American Psychological Association 7th edition) and current ones, preferably published in the last five years, except documents that constitute a reference on the subject under study;
- iii. Funding Entity(ies) maximum 15 words (if applicable);
- iv. The abstract must not include figures, graphs, charts or tables;

v. The authors may write the abstract in Portuguese or English.

b. Summaries of Quality Improvement Projects and Innovative Practices

- i. Abstracts should include: Introduction, conceptual framework; strategies and instruments, results and discussion, conclusions, implications/recommendations for practice; **Keywords** (maximum 5);
- ii. A maximum of 5 bibliographic references (APA Standard -American Psychological Association 7th edition) and current ones, preferably published in the last five years, except documents that constitute a reference on the subject under study;
- iii. Funding Entity(ies) maximum 15 words (if applicable);
- iv. The abstract must not include figures, graphs, charts or tables;
- v. The authors may write the abstract in Portuguese or English.

III - Instructions for making and sending the Oral Communication presentation video

1. make the video

- a. We recommend video production in Pitch format in limited amount time: 3 minutes maximum.
- b. We suggest that speakers record their presentations in the Loom ® program (<u>HTTP: //www.loom.com</u>) records the PPT and the speaker's webcam at the same time, but you can use other software, namely, zoom;
- c. They should record in a place that doesn't have a lot of noise and should have good lighting;
- d. After recording, it must be exported/recorded in MPEG-4 format;
- e. We suggest you *upload* the file to WeTransfer [®] (https://wetransfer.com/) and send the download *link or* upload the file to your *cloud* (Google Drive®, Dropbox®, etc.).
