Applications for the Position of President of the Nursing School of the University of Lisbon

Under the terms set out in the Statutes of the Nursing School of the University of Lisbon (ESEUL), published in the Diário da República (Official Gazette), 2nd series N.º. 180, of September 18, 2025, by Order 11053/2025 of the Rector of the University of Lisbon, of September 12, and pursuant to Annex II: "Electoral Regulation of the Governing Bodies of the Nursing School of the University of Lisbon, a public notice is hereby made for the opening of applications for President of the ESEUL.

The President is elected by the ESEUL School Council and serves as the highest governing body and external representative of the ESEUL.

Any PhD holder who is a tenured professor or permanent researcher at ESEUL, at another school within the University of Lisbon, or at any other national or international higher education or research institution is eligible to apply for the position of President of the ESEUL.

The President of the ESEUL must be an academic of unquestionable prestige, with proven experience in performing leadership roles in similar higher education or research institutions. The candidate must demonstrate strategic vision and dynamism to promote the modernization of the institution, excellence in teaching, research, community engagement and internationalization.

Applications must be addressed to the President of the ESEUL School Council by email to secretariado.ce@esel.pt, written in Portuguese and accompanied by the candidate's CV, an action program, and a written statement confirming the absence of any situation of ineligibility or incompatibility provided for by law and the ESEUL Statutes and Electoral Regulation of the Governing Bodies, by December 2, 2025.
